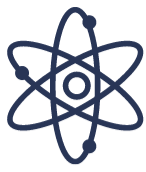

Using the advice of experienced linguists and polyglots (speakers of several languages) on innovative methods of language learning, I will give the following examples. 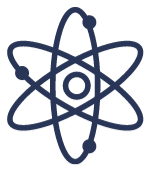

In the process of the development of pedagogical technologies and their penetration into the educational process, as well as rapid exchange and improvement of information technologies, each person has the opportunity to develop his professional training, skills. The introduction of advanced pedagogical technologies into the educational process is one of the stage tasks of the "national program of Personnel Training". Today, innovative pedagogical technologies and interactive methods are widely used in education, especially in teaching foreign languages. The introduction of innovative pedagogical technologies into foreign language education is to direct a person to the requirements of society, to organize education on the basis of these requirements, to form a person as a comprehensively mature person on the basis of the principles and methods of education, to create favorable conditions for the full manifestation and development of his abilities and opportunities. Another characteristic feature of pedagogical innovative technologies is in the priority of the student’s activities, in the process of education the student or the student is the main figura. Recently, a new approach to language learning by a linguist and translator who speaks 12 languages has intrigued me. He read dozens of grammar books to learn Italian,





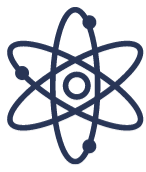
attended language courses and memorized many words, but his efforts were in vain. He then began to study the language using the “listen and repeat” method. A year later, he was fluent in Italian. He uses the same method to learn other new languages and in 3-4 months he will be able to communicate in a new language. As a result, he reaches the level of a linguist and translator who speaks 12 languages. His method of learning the language can be explained as follows: a child cannot speak until he is about two and a half years old, during which time he accumulates vocabulary. However, the child is not taught grammar and is not reprimanded for mistakes. He learns his mother tongue only by listening to others and repeating or practicing what he hears. In the same way, adults increase their vocabulary and begin to speak by repeating what they hear. Most importantly, they don't spend as much time talking as children, because they have language skills and it's easier to learn other languages. It is not necessary to know all the words to speak a new language, even if we do not know many words in our native language, we can communicate very well.

Creating an English environment for a person who wants to learn English, that is, constantly listening, reading, writing and speaking English, is the most effective way to achieve this goal. Most people think, “If I go to a special language course, I will definitely learn a foreign language.” Rather, they think that foreign language courses are responsible for achieving their goals. This is completely wrong.

Remember, you are always responsible for yourself, a teacher can teach you, but Alisher Absalomov says that “99 percent of the lesson depends on you, 1 percent on the teacher.” Effective Methods of Learning. In fact, there are many factors that are important in learning a foreign language, but I would like to enumerate the factors that depend on the learner to establish control, depending on the circumstances in which he or she can organize. I tried.

Above, I talked to language learners about some of the key factors in achieving their goals, and now some of the key factors that can help those who are not able to complete or succeed in the goal of learning a foreign language. I want to mention the mistakes. People are always trying to do things that are fun and enjoyable for them, and they don't even notice how fast time passes. If a new language is learned with great interest and enthusiasm, the goal can be achieved quickly and easily. And we often take this





process for granted, and as a result, the process of learning a new language seems very tedious to us. As a result, you tend to avoid boring activities or spend less time.

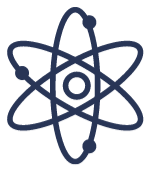
Conversely, when you try to learn, listen, write, and speak in your new language in a field or topic that interests you, you can feel how interesting the process is. For example, sports enthusiasts can watch sports news in the language they are learning, watch sports TV programs in that language, or share their thoughts on the subject in a foreign language. Because I am also interested in the field of IT (information technology), I am always a member of magazines related to IT (information technology) in English, I watch TV programs in this field in English, I watch interesting videos on the social network Youtube I see and summarize the information I have received and speak in English. If I can't find someone to listen to me, it's not a problem, I can tell myself by looking in the mirror (it may seem strange, but it's worth using any method or tool to achieve the goal), especially the dictaphone on today's smartphones is very useful. The next time I hear a mistake in my speech, I try not to repeat it.

Another common mistake many make is setting unrealistic goals. Some spend half an hour or an hour a day learning a new language because of work or study, and two or three hours according to a plan. This suggests that it is better to achieve a goal, even if only a little, in the long run and slowly, rather than to stop altogether or become stressed and useless nervous. A good example of this is the story of the Turtle and the Rabbit. Although slow, the tortoise's patience and perseverance can serve as an example to humans. I would like to add that a good mood, a positive inner experience and good rest are also very important in learning a foreign language. The other 80 percent depends on human psychology. Experts admit that maintaining and shaping a positive inner experience is more powerful than the methods used in language learning.

There is another type of student who collects hundreds of books but rarely uses them in practice. Such students can be compared to someone who buys a bicycle or a car and does not learn its parts, how it works, and how to ride. The advice in any book is only useful if it is put into practice.

In conclusion, learning a new language is not an obligation, it is much easier to learn it if it is considered a hobby or a hobby. It is often up to the student to adapt to the process or to create an interesting environment. Discipline, responsibility and patience
