Uzbekistan. The flora and fauna of Sarmishsay is very wonderful and diverse. In addition, in this gorge there is a stream that flows along the entire Sarmishsay gorge. Sarmishsay About 10,000 petroglyphs were found in the area of 20 km2 of the gorge. It is not known when these petroglyphs first appeared on the rocks of the Sarmishsay gorge. But scientists say that the first settlements of ancient people appeared in the Sarmishsay gorge in the Paleolithic era (approximately 300-25 millennia BC). Traces of Caltaminor culture were left in this gorge during the Neolithic period.

It is known that tribes lived in the Sarmishsay Gorge at that time. They fished and hunted from the Sarmish creek. The natural location of the Sarmish gorge, the abundance of flora and fauna, and the availability of drinking water were very convenient for the ancient people to live and perform various ceremonies. We can learn this from the rock carvings. All paintings were created by ancient people on rocks. The petroglyphs in the gorge depict various scenes and scenes from the life of ancient people. Representatives of the animal world of that time are depicted on the rocks, such as wild horse, mountain goat, boar, saiga, arhar, ox, deer, bison, lion, tiger, leopard, fox, jackal, gazelle. Many species of animals listed above have disappeared. In addition, many petroglyphs are dedicated to hunting.

Some of the petroglyphs depict group hunting, while the rest depict solitary hunting. You can also find images of people performing various rituals and sacrifices on the rocks of Sarmishsay Gorge. In addition, there are amazing images of two-headed aliens on the rocks. Later, more precisely, petroglyphs depicted in the Paleolithic period can also be found here. They depict a shepherd on a horse, a young camel and a large group of people connected together with many inexplicable objects.

Today, the Sarmishsoy gorge has been turned into a national park of petroglyphs belonging to UNESCO. It should be said that the mysterious petroglyphs of the Sarmishsoy gorge, which attract tourists, are the product of the imagination and imagination of our ancestors who lived ten thousand years ago. no wonder. Looking at rock paintings, it is not difficult to realize that our ancestors were interested not only in livelihood but also in art and culture. Also, these photos serve as an excellent source of the way of life, customs, religion and occupations of the primitive people who lived in the region. Each new generation does not always create the basis of material and traditional culture, but relies on the existing cultural wealth created by the previous generations.
