3.The number of students in the class. Having a large number of students in the classroom creates a lot of anxiety and stress for teachers. Because in order to teach a large number of students, teachers have to make more effort and hard work.

The problems faced by many students are:

1. They make noise and disturb the teacher.
2. It will be difficult to manage the students in the class.
3. It will be very difficult to attract a large number of students to study.
4. Educational resources will not be enough for all students.

4. Limited time. Time is very important in learning and teaching English. Teachers need time to observe their students and teach them at their level. However, there is very little class time allocated for teaching this subject. This is a very difficult task for teachers to teach in a short time.

5. The fact that students are attached to teachers. Another notable problem that teachers face is that students are completely dependent on teachers. They do not try to learn and speak themselves. Students always turn to teachers to help them learn and give them the right answers. They do not try to correct words and sentences when speaking English. In this problem, students have not learned the technical terms of using different tenses and words in English.

6. Students who are bored and not interested in learning English. Students' boredom and lack of interest in learning English is also a problem facing teachers.

Sometimes students are not interested in learning English and attending lectures. Then they try to engage in other activities.

Sometimes they disturbed the teachers by talking to others and doing other meaningless things during the lecture.

Along with problems and difficulties, there are certainly solutions to them. The following are the best solutions:

1. Educational competitions in classes

Competitions play a very important role in learning English. it forces students to learn English, such as debates, quizzes, etc.

Various competitions among students make learning English interesting and encourage them to participate in competitions and win among their colleagues.

Competitions make teaching English easier for teachers. Teachers should organize competition activities among students.

2. Using multimedia during the lecture

Often English teachers use old and traditional methods in teaching.

But new devices and gadgets designed specifically for educational purposes can improve English teaching and learning.

Teachers should use multimedia tools in their lectures. This makes learning English more interesting and understandable for students.

Because students can easily understand the idea through visual images, videos, sounds, etc. instead of what is written in books.

3. Teaching through games

Games are the type of activity that engages students the most. Games also play a very important role in education and learning. There are many educational games that can be played in the classroom with students. Games help to increase vocabulary. There is a game of placing the missing word in different types of sentences. It builds vocabulary a lot. Students understand the types of words and their meaning and their place in the sentence. In the process of learning English, teachers should use them to play games in the classroom.

4. Manage lesson and timetable rules

Teachers should make class rules and schedules, and students should follow them. Rules and discipline play a very important role in learning English. Students must turn off their cell phones, not talk to their peers, come to class on time, and complete homework assignments on time and submit them to the teacher. If students violate any of its rules, they should be fined or their parents should be contacted.
