Successful participation in international assessment programs is directly related to improving the quality of education. Participation in it is an important tool in the development and evaluation of creative and logical thinking skills that will be able to apply not only in Uzbekistan but also in the world community from assessing the fact that students have kept their curricula in mind, to assess their competencies, that is, their knowledge acquired in the school in real-life situations.

To enrich the imagination of teachers and students about the research of PISA and PIRLS, to increase the level of preparation for international research, to develop students ' creative and logical thinking skills, thereby contributing to the improvement of the quality of Education, several works were carried out in cooperation with the National Center under it and specialists in the But the problems in preparing students for international assessment programs have not been eliminated by screening. All educators, teachers of a general educational institution should be fully informed about international assessment programs. It would be desirable that the manuals created in

this regard were sufficiently delivered to educational institutions. It is also one of the important issues that students will be able to learn more about international assessment programs, to realize the importance of these programs. And for this, I think that the textbooks should include information about international assessment programs (PISA, PIRLS, TIMSS), assignments prepared for these programs. During the lesson, the reader not only increases his enthusiasm for the lesson by reading new information in the textbook and completing interesting assignments but also makes it possible for him to compete with his peers around the world.

For students to participate Permanently in international PISA, PIRLS, TIMSS, and other darts, it would also be desirable to establish separate circles in schools, in which these circles operate based on specially approved work plans. For this purpose, of course, experienced educators were involved, special work plans were developed and, based on this plan, students who were involved in clubs were controlled to take exams between a certain period (for example, once a month), conditions would have been created for the young people of our country to show high results in international assessment programs.

It should be noted that the assignments set out in the international assessment programs, for example, Pisa assignments, are developed by international experts with mature experience, and for the development of similar assignments, systematic and special knowledge is required. Tasks that are structured without complying with the requirements for PISA assignments can also be confusing to students instead of giving them a go. Therefore, in the process of preparing students for the PISA test, it is important to focus the main attention not on solving individual PISA tasks, but on increasing the overall level of preparation of students who will need to solve them and tasks like them.

One of the important tasks assigned to us, educators, is to constantly search for our students to occupy leading places on a global scale, to have a high level of knowledge and skills, and this is an indicator of the integration of our knowledge into the minds of young people. Therefore, let's take a step forward in line with the demand of the period, which is constantly developing in the conditions of globalization.

The content of pedagogical competence of young teachers in That's it. focused scientific research based on indicators such as motivational, cognitive, operational, reflexive and self-assessment of the successful application of modern information pedagogical technologies in the educational process plays an important role.

The concept of competence came into the sphere of education as a result of the scientific research of pedagogical psychologist researchers. From the psychological point of view, competence refers to "unconventional situations, how a specialist behaves unexpected situations, behaves in a new way in relations with colleagues, in the performance of ambiguous tasks, in the use of Information full of contradictions, consistently developing and having a plan of action in complex processes." The concept of "competence" in English expresses the meaning of "ability".
